

Appendix v-Scout and Parent/Guardian Expectations:

- A Scout will be able to conduct himself by the values instilled in the Scout Oath and Law.
- A Scout will be able to take instruction and follow directions given by other Scouts, including peers and more senior Scouts. Troop 164 employs a boy-led leadership model.
- A Scout will be able to successfully work in a patrol environment.
- A Scout will be able to work independently.
- A Scout will be responsible for his own conduct. Appropriate disciplinary action, including dismissal from the Troop, to correct Scout behavior problems will be enforced by the Troop Committee.
- A Scout will be able to follow rules that are set forth for safety (i.e. buddy system, fire safety, knife safety, etc.).
- A Scout will be able to communicate with adults by himself via in person, by phone and email for Rank Requirements, Scoutmaster Conferences, Boards of Review, merit badges, etc.
- A Scout is responsible for bringing and/or administering appropriate prescription medication.
- A Scout will be able to earn the rank requirements by himself (i.e. pitch a tent, cook, tie knots etc.).
- A Scout will be responsible for bringing the appropriate personal gear to outings.
- A Scout will be responsible for himself and his personal belongings.
- A Scout is expected to tent with fellow scouts and not their parent/guardian.
- Parent/guardian involvement is not just for the benefit of their Scout, but for the benefit of all Scouts in Troop.
- Parent/guardian participation is in background and will not interfere when Scouts or Troop adults are leading.
- Parent/guardians do not challenge Troop adult leaders in front of Troop unless safety is a concern.
- Parent/guardians are expected to volunteer to help the Troop (i.e. coordinate fundraising activities, merit badge counselor, etc.) and to be trained to position if appropriate.
- Parent/guardian is required to take Youth Protection Training if they interact with Scouts and/or Troop functions.
